## Kids, got library fines?

Read them away!

Youngsters up to age 18 with Cerritos Library fines for overdue books are encouraged to participate in the **Read Away Your Fines** program.

## Here is how to participate:

- 1. Cardholder must check in at the Circulation Desk with library staff.
- 2. Library staff will note the time you will start reading.
- 3. Read in the Cerritos Library for at least 30 minutes.
- 4. Cardholder must sign out at the Circulation Desk.
- 5. Library staff will record the amount of time you spent reading and will reduce your fines accordingly.

## The program's benefits and rules follow:

- For every 30 minutes that you read inside the Cerritos Library, the library waives \$2.50 of your fines.
- ★ You must complete your reading while inside the Cerritos Library.
- ★ Cardholders under 5 years old can be read to by an adult.
- ★ You can participate in the program an unlimited number of times.
- ★ It is not possible to build a credit for future fines.
- Only overdue fines for juvenile books and age-appropriate books are waived.
- ★ Fines for lost or damaged items, overdue DVDs and overdue CDs are not eligible for the program.
