

The Cerritos Library is pleased to announce that cardholders will have access to the cloudLibrary[™] digital book service starting on May 17, 2018. The cloudLibrary[™] is easy to use and offers intuitive browsing, reading and listening. E-books and e-audiobooks can be borrowed and downloaded with one click.

The cloudLibrary[™] will replace the OverDrive digital book service, which will be discontinued on May 16, 2018. Please note that holds placed on OverDrive books will not transfer into the cloudLibrary[™]. In addition, books checked out through OverDrive will no longer be available as of May 16. If you are reading a book from OverDrive, please make note of the page you are on and check out the book from the cloudLibrary[™].

The cloudLibrary[™] service can be used on Apple devices and computers, Android tablets and phones, Kindle Fire tablets, Chromebooks and personal computers. The cloudLibrary[™] is not available on Kindle eReaders such as Kindle, Kindle Paperwhite or Kindle Voyage. To assist cardholders who only have the non-compatible Kindle eReaders, the Cerritos Library will make e-readers and tablets available for checkout. The cloudLibrary[™] app will be available for download from the Apple App Store, Google Play Store and Kindle Fire App Store. Alternatively, you can also install the Windows, Chromebook or Apple desktop applications.

The cloudLibrary[™] will offer a similar selection of titles to the OverDrive collection. The cloudLibrary[™] service is available to the Cerritos Library at a lower cost, which will help allow the collection to continue to grow. Cardholders will be able to check out up to five items at a time and the loan period will be three weeks.
